### **Principal's Report:**

- 2 months back into school and things are running smoothly. School wide assemblies have been great.
- October has been Mi'kmaq Heritage Month
  - African drumming workshops happened this month and each class had ½ hour experiences.
- Reading buddies has started back up and is being done on Day 1 of the 8 day cycle. Reading buddies includes the Pre-Primary classes, right up to the Grade 6 class.
- Halloween Centers will be happening this Friday and an alert will be sent home for parents.
- Technology Update: some of the Chromebooks have expired which meant most students had Chromebooks, except for some of the Primary class.
  - o 8 new computers have come in and now all children have one
- Mr. White will finish up this week as the Gym teacher, and Mrs. Tingley will be starting back.
- Lona has officially given notice of retirement as an EA. Shelly McLellan was hired back in to fill this position.
- Province wide professional development happened Friday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>.
  - o The PD day was done virtually
- 2 new students have started in Grade 2, putting the 2/3/4 class over their cap.
  - The three, Grade 4 students were moved from Mrs. Singers class, upstairs to Mrs. Hilchie's class. Now all of the Grade 4's will be in one class, and Mrs. Singers class will become a 2/3 Split.

- Current Class Sizes:
  - o Pre-Primary: 5 students total
  - o Primary/One: 22 total (Primary(8), Grade 1(14))
  - o 2/3: 20 total (Grade 2(9), Grade 3(11))
  - o 4/5/6: 26 total (Grade 4(12), Grade 5(3), Grade 6(11))
- The food policy has been re-visited
  - o In 2006 it was presented
  - Now being much stricter with making healthy choices
  - The breakfast and lunch programs, as well as any food administered at the school must now meet the required standards.

# **SAC Agreement & Bylaws:**

- In 2019/2020 it was sent out for review. Templates were given, and they were re-vamped.
- Last year due to COVID, the reports were not submitted
- Our SAC must include 8 voting members: parents, teacher staff, support staff, principal, community member, and a student.
  - o More than half of the voting members need to be present to make a decision.
  - We are currently seeking a Grade 6 student to fill the space on the committee.
  - o The Annual Report goes out at the end of the year.
- Currently Nicky Smith is Chair, Jill Sutton is Co-Chair and Kristyn Thoms is Secretary.

#### SSP (Student Success Plan):

- Every year assessments are done throughout the school to look at literacy, math and wellbeing.
- Literacy: looking at assessing reading levels, and then comprehension in reading. Behaviors of the readers are assessed.
  - o Celebration wall: for meeting expectations and showing growth and acknowledgement.
  - o Behaviors in writing are evaluated throughout the year as well.
  - Meetings and discussions occur every 6 weeks
- Math: understanding mathematical concepts, problem solving
  - Most children are scared to try in math
  - o Looking at engagement, opportunity, risk taking and communication.
  - Is discussed every 6 weeks.
- Well-Being: sense of belonging, school safety, is school welcoming and inclusive.
  - o Focused on the social-emotional aspects
  - o EDI/MDI are done through the center.

#### **New Business:**

- · Looking to enhance the communication with families at home and really amp it up this year
  - o Website, Facebook, Twitter
  - o Surveys will go home asking families about the best ways to communicate with them
  - o How can we enhance the communication?
- Looking for opportunities to invite families into the school that don't involve academics, so that the school is felt as an all-encompassing space.
- Nicki looking for someone who may be interested in laying the wreath on behalf of the school, for the Remembrance Day Ceremony at the Legion.
