Sara and Keira are from SchoolsPlus, and their specific roles within the school are still being discovered/solidified.
- MathUP Leadership continues. The math coach (Sara Thompson) and Millie worked with teachers/students on the use of open number lines. PD is planned with three local schools.
- UFLI is becoming an exciting new tool for the teachers to work with and be on the same page with teaching.
- Sara Landry, Keira Dacey, and Darci McCabe are working with students on zones of regulation. Tier 1 is whole class, Tier 2 is small groups, and Tier 3 is one on one.
